Description

Relax on the wraparound porch of this circa-1900 farmhouse and take in the ample yard, creek, and wooded ridgelines beyond. Set on +/- 5 rolling acres in Flag Pond, the home pairs real vintage character with room to make it your own. At 2,144 square feet, it offers four bedrooms and a main-level flex room that could work as an office, studio, or guest space. Inside, a grand staircase anchors the foyer and leads up to three bedrooms, while the main floor offers ground floor living with a kitchen, dining room, laundry, full bath, and a first-floor bedroom. The main level living room centers on a propane gas-log fireplace.

A 36x48 pole barn, a detached garage and workshop, and a utility shed give you room for animals, equipment, and projects. The property boasts creek frontage, and the topography lends itself to a variety of uses such as agriculture, hobby gardening, or homesteading.

Looking for more acreage? This property is part of a larger tract with an additional +/- 15 tract is available to purchase in tandem with the farmhouse, opening opportunity with wooded hillside, trails, and timber, pasture for hay or animals, as well as potential for entrepreneurial efforts such as RV, glamping, or camping sites.

Conveniently located in Unicoi County with no city taxes, the home is about 20 minutes from Johnson City's shopping, dining, and medical care, and under an hour from Asheville with easy access to I-26. Amenities like Rocky Fork State Park, the Nolichucky River, and the Appalachian Trail sit close by. Events like the Apple Festival in Erwin and the Ramp Festival in Flag Pond are community calendar highlights, and you can even watch the annual local fireworks from the front porch.
