Deeded driveway access is included as part of the tract itself, guiding you into the interior where the land gradually rises to elevated portions with impressive vantage points and strong lake view potential, depending on homesite positioning. The entrance and deeded driveway access remain raw and unimproved, allowing a future owner to develop access

according to their plans for the property.

The natural contours offer flexibility for thoughtfully selecting a future build site that balances accessibility, privacy, and views--allowing you to shape the property according to your vision while embracing the character of the surrounding mountains.

A truly distinctive feature of this tract is that the original Appalachian Trail route crosses the upper ridgeline near the historic Morton Gap area, adding authenticity and a tangible connection to the early heritage of one of America's most iconic trails. For those who appreciate outdoor tradition and the enduring legacy of the Appalachian highlands, this rare attribute enhances both the character and long-term appeal of the property.

Backing directly to the Cherokee National Forest, the tract enjoys a preserved and undeveloped natural boundary that enhances privacy and the natural character of the surroundings. The adjoining national forest provides a scenic backdrop and abundant wildlife movement--ideal for those who value seclusion and on-property recreation such as hiking and hunting.

With Watauga Lake immediately nearby, boating, fishing, kayaking, and lakeside relaxation become part of the lifestyle rather than a distant destination. The broader area offers year-round adventure, from trout fishing on the Watauga and Doe Rivers to exploring the mountain communities of Northeast Tennessee and nearby Western North Carolina. Winter recreation is within convenient reach at North Carolina ski resorts, while Bristol Motor Speedway and other regional attractions provide additional entertainment and regional draw.
